Notes About Registration:

- Please make sure you register directly with CNYCSS by using your online account (preferred) or mail in form even if you have been approved to attend by your school district and/or the district is paying for your conference costs.
- When you register on the CNYCSS website you are informing our organization of your intent to attend this event and when mailed payments are received our VP for Membership will update your account to reflect this.
- If you are able to register on the website, please do. This makes the registration process much more efficient. Mail-in registrations have to be processed manually by our VP for Membership which takes time. In addition, on the day of the conference if you are registered and paid in advance you simply have to stop by the Registration Table upon arrival to collect conference materials and then proceed to the continental breakfast and days’ events!
